 - Defining tone
 - Specifying audience
 - Adding format
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Exercise 3 – Add Constraints & Formatting (Medium)

Poor Prompt:

Explain Python.

Task:

Rewrite this prompt by:

- Defining audience level
- Limiting length
- Choosing output format (bullet points / steps)
- Removing ambiguity



Exercise 4 – Scenario-Based (Medium)

You are creating content for a YouTube course on Prompt Engineering.

Task:

Write a structured prompt asking AI to:

- Act as a professional trainer
 - Explain “Clarity in Prompting”
 - Use simple language
 - Limit explanation to 150 words
 - Present in short paragraphs
